

Pattern Installation Guide

Transform Your Space with Sophisticated Flooring Patterns

Chevron Pattern

Visual Impact: Creates striking V-shaped lines with planks cut at angles (45-60°) that meet at perfect points. Adds movement and elegance, ideal for formal spaces.

Material Requirements: Requires 10-15% extra material for angle cuts and waste. Uses precision-cut planks, typically 2-4" wide and 12-24" long.

Installation: Professional installation essential. Requires perfectly level subfloor. Takes 50-100% longer than standard flooring.

Herringbone Pattern

Visual Impact: Forms a broken zigzag with rectangular planks at 90° angles. Creates a woven appearance that works in both traditional and modern settings.

Material Requirements: Uses standard rectangular planks (no angle cuts). Add 5-10% for waste. Common sizes: 2-3" wide, 8-12" long.

Installation: Requires skilled installation but less complex than chevron. Takes 30-50% longer than standard flooring.

Mansion Weave Pattern

Visual Impact: Creates an intricate basket-weave effect with planks arranged in alternating horizontal and vertical groups. Adds luxury and dimension to formal spaces.

Material Requirements: Uses uniform planks in 3:1 or 4:1 ratios. Plan for 8-12% extra material. Can incorporate contrasting woods for enhanced effect.

Installation: Demands exceptional precision and detailed layout planning. Often includes borders.

Versailles Panels

Visual Impact: The pinnacle of elegance featuring intricate geometric patterns within bordered panels. Creates an opulent, palace-inspired floor.

Material Requirements: Pre-fabricated panels typically 24-48" square. Order 10-15% extra. Often combines different wood species for contrast.

Installation: Most complex pattern requiring master craftsmanship. May need subfloor reinforcement.

- **Room Size:** Large patterns (Versailles) need spacious rooms; chevron and herringbone work in smaller spaces
- **Budget:** Factor both materials (including waste) and labor costs
